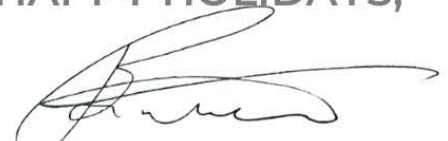
Here's what you've already helped us accomplish:
